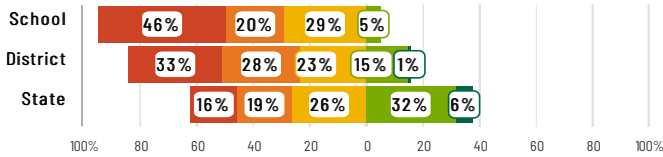

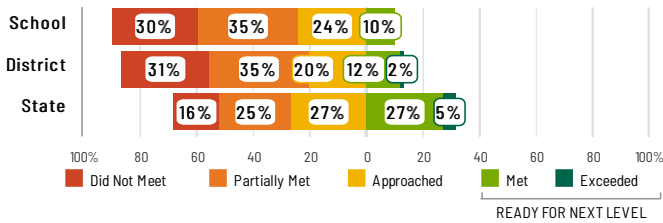
## Academic Success

### English Language Arts



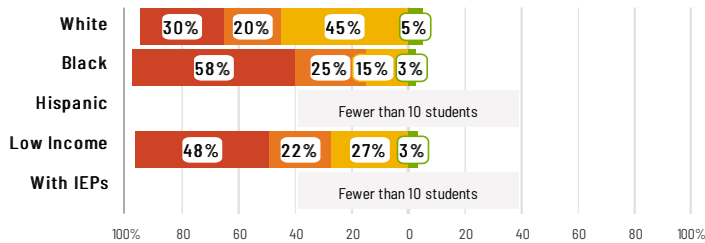

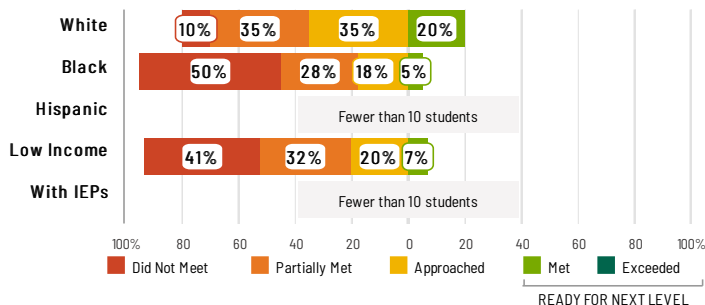
## Success by Student Group

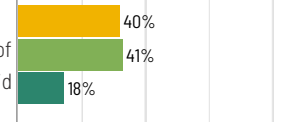
### Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



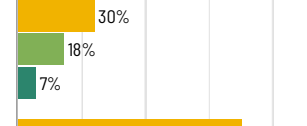
### Chronic Absenteeism

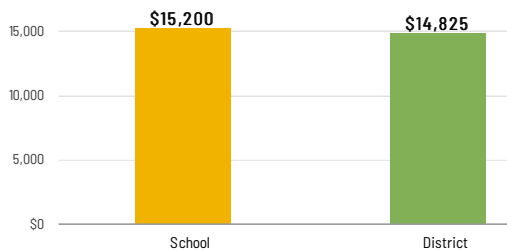

### Facilities

Edison has three levels, a gymnasium, cafeteria, library, computer lab, outdoor playground with various pieces of equipment for students to enjoy. A large grass area for Physical Education and other school celebrations throughout the year.

## School-Level Finance
