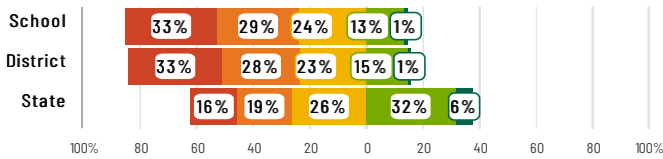

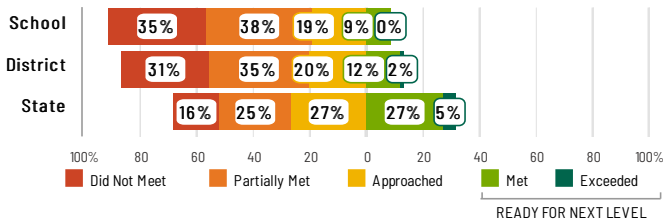
Academic Success

English Language Arts



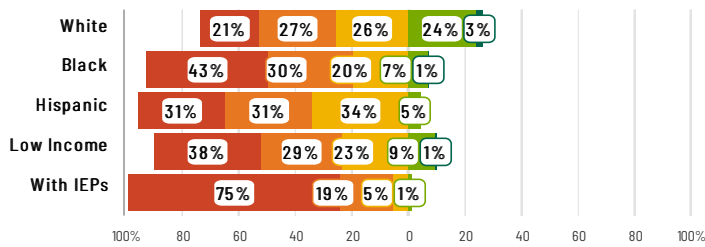

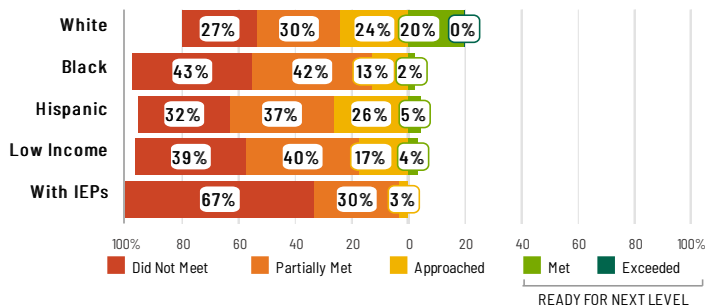
Success by Student Group

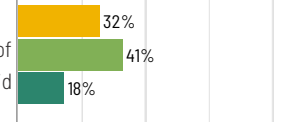
Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



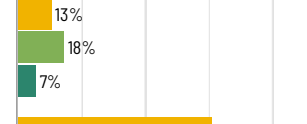
Chronic Absenteeism

School Personnel Resources

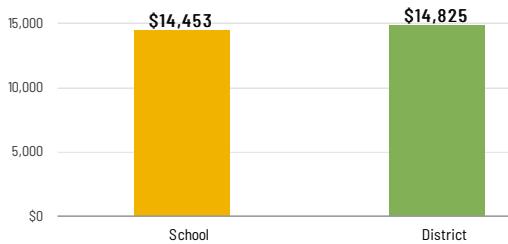
North Ridge Middle School strives to meet the needs of each student. Each student has a daily RtI/Intervention time built into the Master Schedule. Students not in need of interventions are offered enrichment activities. Students have access to two Guidance Counselors, a Social Worker and a Psychologist.

Facilities

North Ridge has recently been renovated. Each classroom is equipped with air-conditioning and heating that can be controlled by the teacher. All classrooms have a phone line, so that parents can speak directly to a classroom teacher. The school has two levels. Located in the lower level is the gym, band room and the new cafeterium, with a stage for

School-Level Finance
