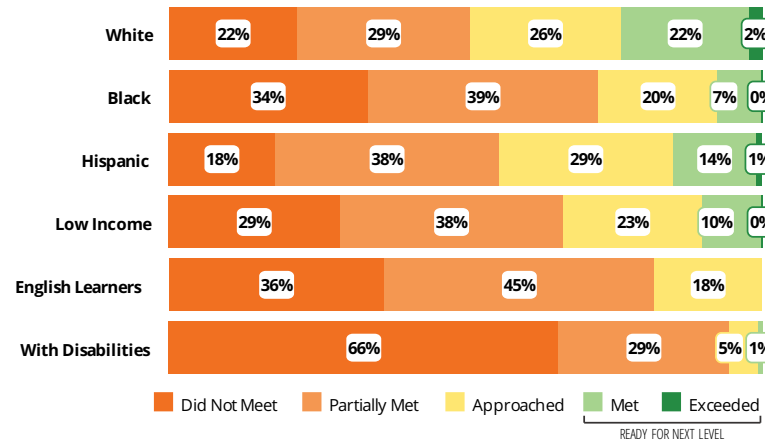
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

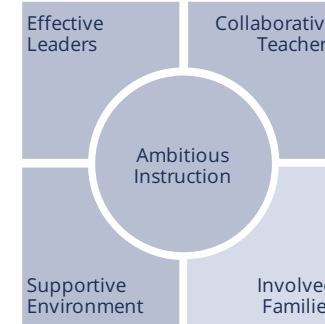
This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

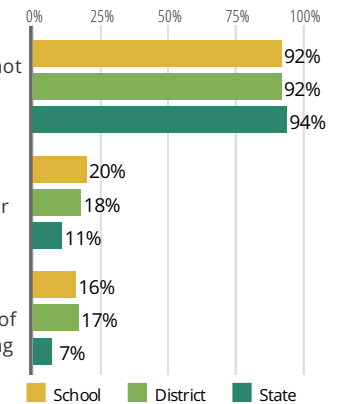

North Ridge offers 25 Academic Courses, including Six (6) Special Education Classrooms, the MATS Program and the AVID Program. School Personnel Resources

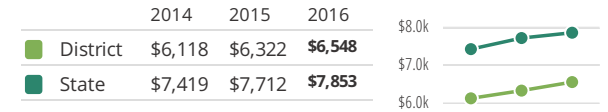

Facilities

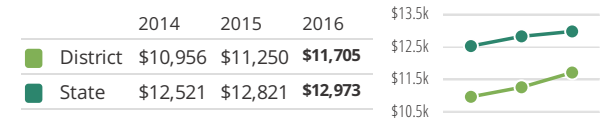
