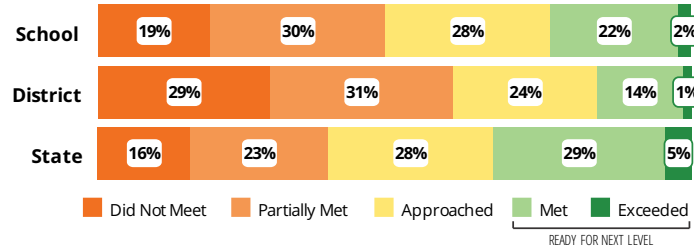

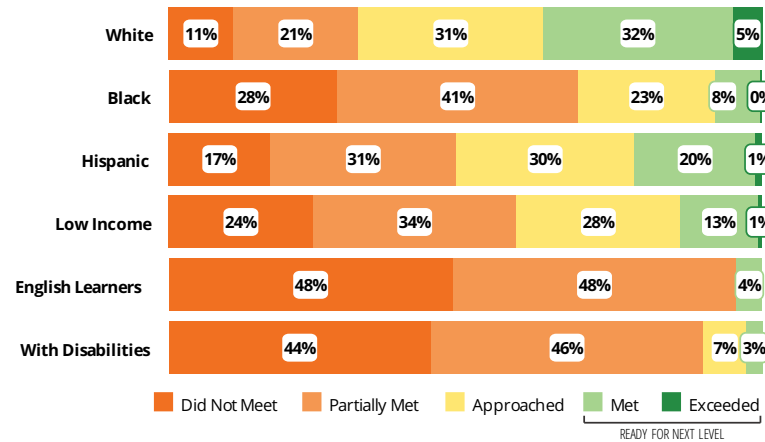
## Academic Success

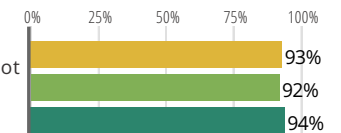

## Student Attendance and Mobility

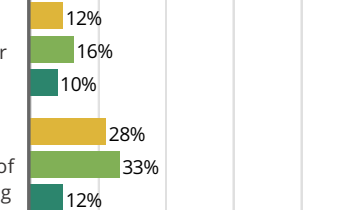
### Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



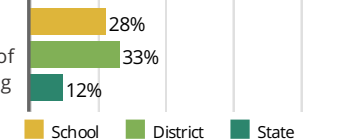
### Chronic Truancy Rate

North Ridge Middle School offers several Extra-Curricular opportunities for students in grades 6-8.

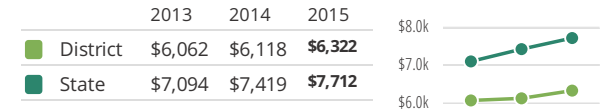
### School Personnel Resources

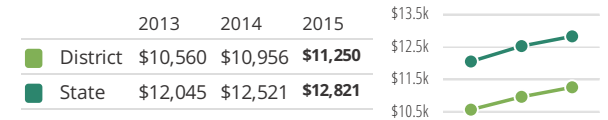
