Notes from the Nurse

The following will need to be in your student's file before your student can start Kindergarten on 8/14/24:

Current Physical (dated 8/14/2023 or after)-this <u>must</u> include blood lead screening and diabetes risk assessment

Current, up to date immunization record

Eye Examination by an Optometrist or Waiver (Due by 10/15/2024)

Dental Exam (Due by 5/15/2025)

The sooner you get these completed and turned into the nurse's office, the better. Doctors' offices get very busy over the summer with school physicals and immunizations, which can make it difficult to get an appointment. Getting everything completed as soon as possible will make your Kindergarten registration process easier. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school nurse.
