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Dear Parent or Guardian,

Public Act 093-0282 amended Section 14-8.02 of the School Code, requiring information to be sent to parents or guardians of students who have met eligibility criteria for visual impairment, deaf, or hearing impairment regarding The Illinois School for the Deaf (ISD) or the Illinois School for the Visually Impaired (ISVI).

As always, the IEP team will make a recommendation for the most appropriate services and placement for your child. Most children's needs can be met in Danville District 118. The Public Act does however give parents and guardians the right to ask ISD and/or ISVI for an evaluation to determine if placement in their respective programs would be an appropriate placement consideration. The Illinois School for the Deaf and the Illinois School for the Visually Impaired have their own intake committees which review all applications.
