GAME DESIGN & DEVELOPMENT

Are you interested in learning how to design and develop video games? Then join us for this series of classes and learn how to create video games from the ground up. Use the Unity Engine to create your project and learn the basics of C# programming language to write basic game logic. Create simple 2D animation using premade art and learn basic game design principles to incorporate into your game. Each level in this series of classes you will build upon existing knowledge so the classes must be taken in sequence. COURSES MUST BE TAKEN IN SEQUENCE. AGES 10-18.

COURSE 1 - \$100

You'll be using the basics of Unity, the platform for game design. Learn how to set up scenes, create scripts that use the basic variable types, and how to save data using PlayerPrefs and more. You will develop three games gaining more knowledge with each one.

July 11-15 from 9:00-11:30

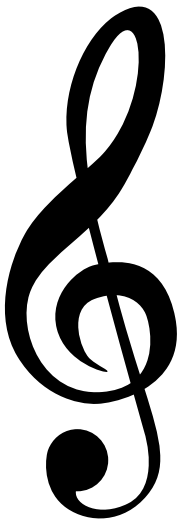
